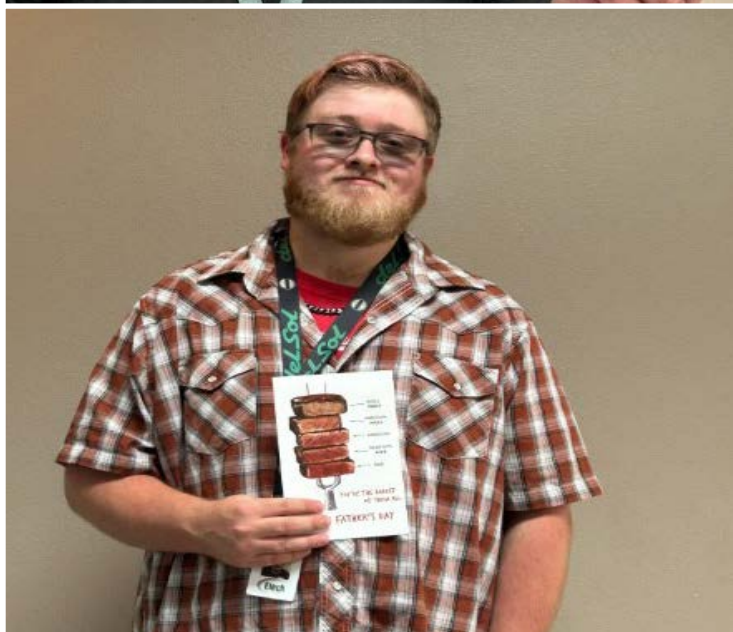

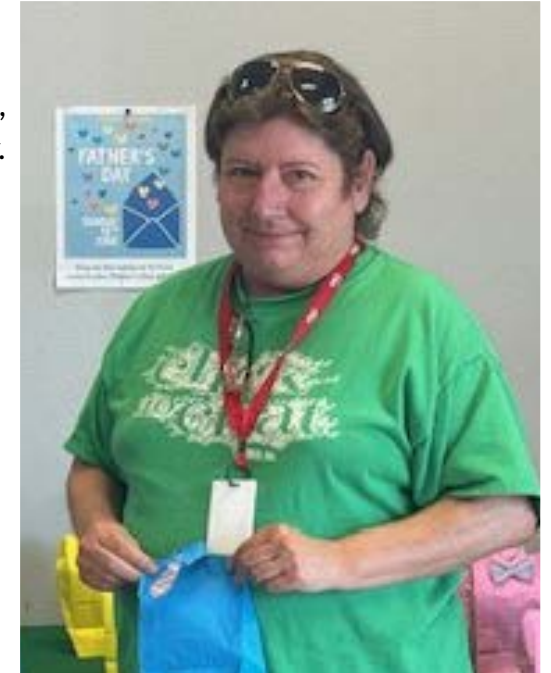
### Team Nacogdoches – Father's Day
